Use Sheriff at a rate of 2.5% v/v of the total spray solution, e.g.

Alternatively, where potato seed treatments (e.g. Honesty[®]) require 2.0 – 2.4 L of spray solution per ton of potato seed, use 50 mL of **Sheriff** per ton of potato seed, e.g.

Mixing and Application

Mixina

Follow the instructions for use of the crop protection product that is being used to protect the seed. Ensure application equipment is properly calibrated.

If preparing the spray mixture in a single tank – always add Sheriff last. First add water (half fill or as required on the pesticide label). Then measure the appropriate amount of crop protection product into the tank and agitate. Measure the appropriate amount of Sheriff into the tank and continue agitating until mixed well.
